Eligibility & Application Process

Both your business and employees selected for training must meet certain requirements to be approved for an Employee Training Grant.

Businesses must:

- be located in Pierce County and licensed within local, state, and federal requirements.
- be in the Manufacturing sector
- not have laid off workers within 120 days
- demonstrate how the training will allow your organization to retain trained workers or provide career advancement.
- be current in unemployment insurance and worker's compensation taxes, penalties, and/or interest or related payment plan.
